Tops Markets improves customer experience with upgraded lighting

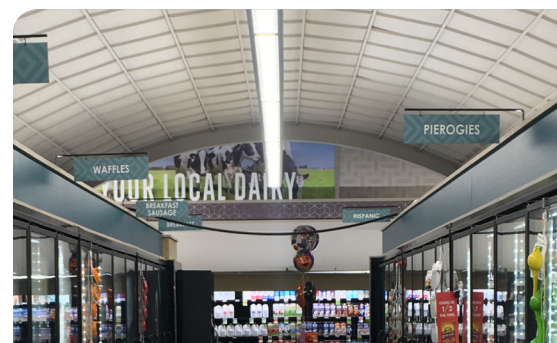
Tops Markets is a supermarket chain headquartered in Buffalo, New York. With over 150 locations throughout the Northeast, they are the largest supermarket chain in the region.

One of the stores in Rochester, New York recently decided to upgrade their lighting in the freezer aisle to dramatically improve the shopping experience for the customer and boost sales. LSI has worked with Tops in the past, providing several outdoor lighting upgrades. This particular store had no lighting in the freezer aisle, with the freezer case lights serving as the sole source of illumination. LSI installed 18 eight-foot Clarity fixtures to improve the customer experience.

Clarity provides 40% uplight and 60% downlight, illuminating the floor and brightening the ceiling. This increases visual acuity, the perceived brightness of the space, and prevents the shadowing normally associated with the "cave effect." A second Clarity installation at a nearby location followed this installation, with plans for more in the future.

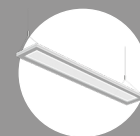
CHALLENGE

Tops Markets in Rochester, New York did not have lighting in the freezer aisle, creating a poor customer experience and limited consumer traffic.



SOLUTION
